- Opportunities to develop independent business activities, including operating travel services or running travel agencies.

- Opportunities to work as researchers or lecturers in tourism at universities, colleges, and research institutes.

- Participation in short-term professional training and capacity-building programs related to tourism and travel services both domestically and internationally.

- Enrollment in other undergraduate programs in related disciplines.

- Enrollment in postgraduate programs in tourism or other disciplines related to the tourism economy at universities in Vietnam or abroad.

## **7. TEACHING, LEARNING METHODS AND LEARNING ASSESSMENT**

### **7.1. Teaching Methods**

#### ***Teaching preparation***

- Teaching materials, learning guides, and instructional equipment (if required).
- Practical exercises and case studies related to the course content.

#### ***Teaching and Learning Methods***

- Direct instruction: Lectures, Classroom discussions, presentations.
- Indirect instruction: Guided questioning, Problem-based learning, Case-based learning, Group-based learning.
- Experiential learning: internship, Field trip, Case studies.
- Interactive learning: Discussions, Teamwork activities.
- Self-directed learning: Homework assignments, Case analysis and problem-solving tasks.

#### ***Continuous Improvement in Teaching***

In addition to flexibly applying the above teaching and learning methods, lecturers are expected to continuously improve their teaching approaches and adopt modern higher-education pedagogical methods to help students achieve the PLOs and enhance overall teaching quality. Those emphasize the integration of educational technologies and innovative teaching strategies that promote students' active learning, creativity, independence, and critical thinking. This approach encourages students to take responsibility for their own learning, actively explore academic resources such as textbooks, scholarly articles, and professional journals, and develop the ability to identify and solve real-world problems.
